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welcome to ALL HALLOWS

This area next to the church of All Hallows, is being cared for by volunteers to provide a relaxing green space for local people and wildlife. We have developed a lovely wildlife walk, which takes you through the wooded area and to the banks of the Gill Beck (please take care next to the water). Let your eyes rest, enjoy the peace and the peace.

This board is a guide to the wildlife you might see in the glade.

Holly

Mature holly trees can grow up to 15m and live for 300 years. Younger plants have spiky leaves, but the leaves of older trees are much more likely to be smooth.

Red campion

The red campion is a common flower in the glade. It is a member of the Malvaceae family and is a favourite of bees and butterflies.

Grovelier tree

The first-topped flowers of the grovelier tree appear in May to July. Each leaf-like cluster of flowers is enclosed by a ring of larger flowers.

Goldfinch

The woodcock has distinctive colouration between the male and female. The bulk of the song is high and piping whistled call are usually the first signs of goldfinches being present.

Red kite

Following its near extinction in the 1900s, numbers of this large bird of prey are now increasing. They can be regularly seen over the glade.

Goldfinch on trail

This striking bird can often be seen on the paths which grow in the wild area.

Long tailed tit

This tiny bird's tail is longer than its body. They are often seen in small, visible groups and are known as 'chickadees', building elastic nests which grow with the size of the chicks.
